From 1 April 2019, the Data Protection (Charges and Information) (Amendment) Regulations 2019 exempted the processing of personal data by elected representatives.

Elected representatives' is defined by the Data Protection Act 2018 and includes elected councillors in parish councils.

In accordance with the guidance, we are not currently required to pay a fee to the Information Commissioners Office (ICS).

We are required to appoint a Data Protection Officer (DPO) who will be responsible for monitoring compliance with the UK GDPR and other data protection laws. We will take account of our DPO's advice and the information they provide on our data protection obligations.
